2020 SHOW GUIDELINES

- The Quilt Show is open to all current Common Threads Quilt Guild members. A non-member wishing to submit an entry may do so only after first joining the Guild (\$20.00).
- **Show admission** is \$7.00 per day. **All CTQG members will be charged a *one-time* \$7.00 admission fee.**

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Each entry must have a completed entry form – only one entry per form. There are no entry fees.
- **Member will determine the Entry Category for each item. However, the Show Committee retains the right to move an entry to a more appropriate category.**
- **Challenge Quilt: *STARS*** – Any size quilt, or other item, with a star/stars being the predominate focus of the overall entry. **Describe why you chose this pattern.**
- **2020 COVID 19-Related Category** – Any quilt or other item the theme of which is related to 2020 COVID-19.
- **FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY FORMS IS JULY 15 — at the meeting, postmarked, or emailed to Registrar. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THAT DATE. If in question, submit the entry form—it may be withdrawn later. Registrar: Sharon Koepper, pskoepper@gmail.com, 317-753-6568.**
- All entries must be in good, clean condition and not previously displayed at a Common Threads Quilt Guild Show. Show Committee has right to refuse to display entry if soiled. A hanging sleeve is not required.
- **Every quilt must have a label sewn into the quilt to be accepted for the Show.**
- **Each entry**, including clothing and miscellaneous categories, must be brought in a **labeled** pillowcase or cloth bag. **ABSOLUTELY NO PLASTIC BAGS.**
- Full quilts may not always be displayed due to available space.
- First, second, and third place ribbons will be awarded unless the Judge decides otherwise.

ENTRY DROP-OFF, HANGING, AND RELEASE

- **All entries will be accepted between 9 a.m. and 10:30 a.m., THURSDAY, August 27.**
- **No entries will be taken down before 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 29.**
- Hanging and taking down quilts will be completed by a select committee.
- **All entries shall be picked up between 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Saturday, August 29.** Claim Checks must be presented when picking up entries. If Entrant cannot pick up her/his entry(ies), the person picking up the entry(ies) must present the Claim Check signed by the Entrant.

MEMBER VOLUNTEERS

- **All members** are asked to sign up for **two-hour shifts** in the *Quilty Café*, *Harvest Gift Shoppe*, and/or admissions, as well as for **set-up** and **take-down in these areas**. All Guild member volunteers will be identified.
- **Each member** is asked to make or bring **5 or more items for the *Harvest Gift Shoppe***. **No garage sale items, PLEASE.** Magazines, fabric, rulers, quilt pattern books, and other sewing/quilting notions will be accepted. Grab bags will be available for sale. The last day for *Harvest Gift Shoppe* items to be accepted will be the July 15 meeting.
- **Each member** is asked to donate in a disposable container baked goods/desserts to be sold in the *Quilty Café*.
- **All members** are asked to help with **clean-up** after the show.
- **Participation by every member makes a great show. Husbands and family are needed for set-up beginning at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, August 27, and tear-down beginning at the close of the Show, 3:00 p.m., Saturday, August 29.**
